A look back at this week.....

Reading: The students continued reading the novel, *Hoot*, this week. *Ask your child about it! The kids are really enjoying the story!!* We focused on the following skills: summarizing, theme, homophones, and Greek roots.

Language: We reviewed parts of speech and correcting sentences. Additional daily practice was used to help reinforce all 5th grade language skills.

Math: The kids worked on these skills this week: finding the area/perimeter of irregular rectangles, multiplication, division, and story problems.

Social Studies: The students began their chapter on the Westward Expansion. They learned about the Lewis and Clark expedition as well as the War of 1812.

Science: The class continued with their unit on the solar system.
