- You may submit an application to college before you have taken the ACT or SAT.
- You should send as many scores directly to colleges as you can.
 - Many schools such as IU, Purdue, and University of Indianapolis will only take scores directly from SAT or ACT.

- If you need a letter of recommendation from any faculty or staff, **DON'T WAIT UNTIL THE LAST MINUTE!**
- Apply on-line
- Once application has been submitted, request a transcript from Parchment. (See following slide)
- Many schools have a counselor form that needs submitted as well- bring it to us.

Parchment- Indiana's eTranscripts

- Indiana now requires that student transcripts be sent electronically to all colleges.
- Parchment is the service that we will be sending transcripts through.
- Your student will create their account.
- When they need to request a transcript, they will go to the guidance office website and follow the link to Parchment. Or speak to a counselor.

Financial Aid- the FAFSA

- All students who plan on attending a post-secondary school (2 or 4-year college, Tech or Business College, Proprietary school) must complete a FAFSA
 - FAFSA stands for Free Application for Federal Student Aid
- FAFSA deadline is April 15th, 2025
 - Recommend completion by March 1st, 2025
 - Application is available December 1st, 2024
- North will be hosting a FAFSA Completion Day
 - This will be the same people who host the Financial Aid Night

- Ask for recommendations early.

- Cost is \$70.25

- 6 sub-scores and an overall composite
 - Each out of 36

SAT®

- Cost is \$68.00
- Register online
- Fee waivers are available! See Guidance
- Receive two sub-scores from 0-800 (1600 max total)

CEEB Code for NDHS is **151 368**. This is for both tests.

Super-Scored SAT/ACT

- Some colleges and universities super-score the ACT/SAT
- Super Scoring involves taking the highest section scores from multiple SAT/ACT test sittings and creating a composite.
- This allows for the best possible composite score for the student and also encourages the student to take the exam more than once

How Do I Sign Up for the ACT?

Online registration is the fastest method. You will know immediately if your preferred test center has space for you to test, and you also can print your admission ticket from the website. How you sign up depends on where and how you plan to test: please see below for how to register.

Reminder: You need to **register by mail** only if you are **younger than 13** or cannot pay by credit card.

- If you plan to test at a **national or international test center**, sign up online by creating or logging in to your **ACT Web account**
- If you are requesting **extended time** or **other accommodations** for the first time, sign up online by creating or logging in to your **ACT Web account** or **register by mail** in addition to completing the application request and submitting required documentation.
- If you missed the late registration deadline, you can **request standby testing** online.
- If you are **homebound** (U.S. and Canada) **center** and one is not outside the U.S. or **Testing**

- Send your test scores directly to the NCAA by selecting 9999
- Talk to your coach for more information

Senior Year Timeline

Fall/ Winter:

- Take SAT or ACT (if you haven't already done so)
- **Attend Decatur County College Fair in Sept from 5:30 to 7:00pm**
- Apply to colleges
- Visit post-secondary schools
- Pay for cap and gown
- **Apply for scholarships**
- Apply for FAFSA ID# for both parent and student

Spring:

- Submit FAFSA form by March 1, 2025(Final deadline is April 15th)
- Complete Senior Affirmation if you are a 21st Century Scholar
- Compare preliminary financial aid packages
- Make final decision about college choice
